• 2022: 100 fatalities (preliminary)

2021: 101 fatalities

• 65% of fatalities in 2022 were not wearing a seat belt (in cases where seat belts were present in the vehicle).

## 2023-25 GOVERNOR'S BUDGET PROPOSAL

### \$2.4 BILLION INVESTMENT in INFRASTRUCTURE

- \$1.2B in federal funds from IIJA
- \$174 M to match federal formula funds
- \$226 M to match federal discretionary funding (grants)
- \$140 M for Flexible Transportation Fund
- Proposed Amendment to free up \$10 M from last biennium for Townships.



## FLEXIBLE TRANSPORTATION FUND



#### **PURPOSE**

To provide sustainable funding flexibility to deliver priority transportation projects on and off the state highway system.

#### **FUNDING USES**

- Projects on and off the state highway system
- To match federal funds and grants
- To support operations, facilities, and equipment.
