


Current Hall County Road Conditions

184 Miles of Asphalt Road:

- 10 Miles are currently scheduled for a recycling or return to gravel project.
- 20 Miles are currently more than 20 years since last overlay or construction.
- 40 Miles are currently 15 to 20 years old since last overlay or construction.
- 30 Miles are currently 10 to 15 years old since last overlay or construction.

The remaining 40% of Hall County Paved roads are in Good Condition
