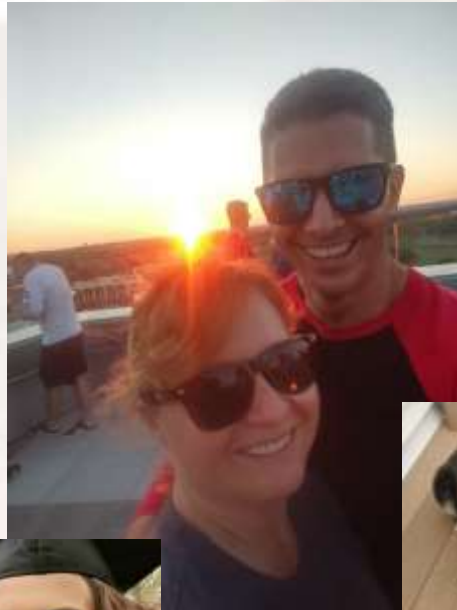

Wattle Installation

Stake spacing as required by contract.

Note: Install fiber roll/wattles along a level contour.

Fiber roll/wattles

Vertical spacing along face of the slope varies between 30 ft and 20 ft.

Install a fiber roll/wattles near slope where it transitions into a steeper slope.

Typical Fiber Roll/Wattle Installation

Slope varies

Fiber roll/wattles

Excavated material

Wood stake

Stake depths as required by contract.
