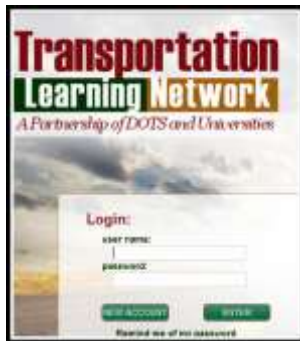
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Need a Quick Technical Overview?

Transportation Learning Network Provides Free Web-Based Training

For most of us, time is a precious commodity and we sometimes need a technical overview for some technology, technique, or concept but we don't have the luxury of attending a full day training workshop right now, away from our workplace.

The Transportation Learning Network offers a host of self-paced courses to use for free. These courses are available if you have an account with the TLN Learning Management System (LMS).

The courses typically run less than an hour in length. Some courses are very basic and other are intended for a more intermediate or advanced audience.

Some training topics available on the LMS:

- Rural Road Safety
- Bridge Construction Inspection
- Bridge Site Safety Worker Orientation
- Flagger Training
- High Visibility Garments
- Materials Testing
- Personal Protective Equipment

Some National Highway Institute courses are also available through the TLN Learning Management System. Many of the NHI courses were developed by the Transportation Curriculum Coordination Council (TCCC), a partnership between Federal Highway Administration



(FHWA), state departments of transportation, and the highway industry.
