


## Speed Management: A Manual for Local Rural Road Owners and Non-Motorized User Safety: A Manual for Local Rural Road Owners

The Local Rural Road Owners' Manual is an addition to the four previously (Road Safety Information Analysis, Roadway Departure Safety, Intersection Safety and Developing Safety Plans) published documents which were developed with a focus on the local rural transportation practitioner. As with the previous four, this

document is not a substitute for other documents with similar content but provide concise methodologies in addressing each area. The manuals provide a framework that can be used to identify and address safety issues on local rural roads. Rural roads continue to experience a fatality rate approximately 2.5 times higher than in urban areas.
