The TRB Roadway Safety Culture Subcommittee, in partnership with American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) and the Governors Highway Safety Association (GHSA), will host a webinar on July 8, 2014, to discuss the concept of traffic safety culture. Safety culture is a hot topic in the transportation community but everyone seems to define it different. Safety culture of organizations is different from the safety culture of the traveling public, although this distinction is not always clear. Confusion remains about what safety culture looks like, how it can be measured, and what factors influence it. Ultimately, this webinar aims to better define safety culture, clarify common misconceptions, and help the transportation community get on the same page about this concept.


