Technical Outreach for November - December:

County	Activity
Billings	Met with Jeff Iverson, Highway Superintendent, to discuss road projects in Billings County and will follow up with discussion on the erionite issue in Billing County.
Divide	I met with Bryan Haugenoe, Road Superintendent to discuss the access road to the county shop. Bryan and I agreed the roadway is performing well. Details were discussed on the 2 miles of road for field road design. NDLTAP will be setting up a workshop for March/April to review roadway design basics.

Dunn	I had a phone conversation with Mike Zimmerman, Highway Superintendent, in regards to the project from north of South Heart to Manning. I drove the road it is looks good. I had some questions on the tapered ends section connects of concrete pipe.
Golden Valley	I met with Pete Wirtzfield, Highway Superintendent, to discuss local road projects. Pete reported that the Six Mile Bell Lake Road Project had been finalized.
Stark	I observed the bridge replacement north of Richardton, ND. While in Stark County I checked the low water crossing in southwest Stark County, and the bridge replacement guardrail north of Richardton. I met with Larry Gangl, NDDOT and Dave Leftwich, NDDOT to discuss Stark County road projects. I will be writing an article on the bridge replacement in the near future.

- December 9 the Statewide Roll-out Webinar GRIT 1.0 was held. Development of the Geographic Roadway Inventory Tool is a team effort, led by UGPTI. A steering committee comprised of ten county transportation leaders, NDDOT
