## **Technical Outreach for Feb. - April 2016:**

County	Activity
Adams	I met with Theo Schalesky, Road Superintendent, to discuss upcoming training opportunities and road issues in the county.
Bowman	I met with Neil Hofland, Road Superintendent to discuss current road projects and road issues. I also presented Neil Hofland with the NDLTAP Road Scholar Award - Level I for the 2015 training year.
Hettinger	I met with Lee Meier, Road Superintendent, to discuss upcoming training opportunities that are available for the county operators. I also met with Kerry Schoch to provide him with Gravel Roads Construction & Maintenance Guide for the Township Association Annual Meeting.
McLean	McLean County hosted the NDLTAP - OSHA Excavating and Trench Awareness training.
McKenzie	McKenzie County participated in the NDLTAP Motor-Grader Operator classroom training.

This program looks at the service level of the unpaved road to determine the maintenance and materials used to maintain that service level. The instructor discussed the hidden costs of an unpaved road to both the agency and the driving public.

	I participated in the Gravel Roads Academy hosted by Stark County. The Gravel Roads Academy training consists of:  Road Design: Understanding of construction to reshaping including shape and drainage, aggregate considerations, and alternatives  Road Maintenance: Understanding of grading to material replacement  Road Stabilization: Understanding of the process involved, the products required, and the benefits you can expect  Program Efficiency: Understanding of cost vs. savings, air quality and safety, and potential sources of funding  The training consists of 1/2 day classroom training and 1/2 day of field training.
