

They make up 20% of all collisions.






# #1 Cause of Death for Teens... CAR CRASHES #1 Reason... DRIVER INEXPERIENCE

## Mission of Alive at 25

To help young drivers choose safe driving practices, take responsibility for their behavior and be aware of typical driving hazards.

- 4-hour classroom setting
- Curriculum specifically written and designed for drivers who are 14-24
- Taught by certified instructors





### What is Alive at 25

- Alive at 25 is an innovative, young driver intervention program – bridging the gap between what teens learn in driver's education and what behaviors and skills they need to become responsible, crash-free drivers.
- This is done through interactive media segments, workbook exercises, class discussions and role playing.
- Young drivers learn how to take control of situations by understanding the consequences of their actions.
- Some insurance companies may offer discounts with certificates of completion

## Session One

#### What's Stopping Me?

- Recognize that people aged 14-24 are more likely than anyone else to be injured or killed in a vehicle crash
- Recognize that every behavior is a choice
- Define "preventable collision" and explain the characteristics of a preventable collision



## **Session Two**

#### Am I Aware

- Demonstrate adequate knowledge of state driving laws
- Describe the consequences of making poor judgments
- Identify behaviors that can be controlled
- Identify the risks associated with specific driving choices and behaviors, including: Driving without safety belts and driving at unsafe speeds
- Explain the risks and challenges associated with intersections and right-of-way situations
- Describe techniques for properly navigating intersections and handling right-of-way situations



## **Session Three**

#### What's the Risk?

- Identify the risks associated with specific driving choices and behaviors, including:
  - Following too closely
  - Distracted driving
  - Impaired driving
  - Aggressive driving
  - Road rage



### Session Four

- Recognize potential hazards when driving and make appropriate driving choices to avoid those hazards
- Identify actions to take to handle different driving situations, both as a driver and a passenger
- Identify possible outcomes of choosing unsafe driving behaviors
- Create a personal plan to make effective driving choices
