



## ATSSA – Northland Chapter Conference Grants Available

A limited number of grants are being offered to the Northland Chapter of the American Traffic Safety Services (ATSSA) How To Conference March 20-21, 2018 at the Delta Hotels by Marriot in Fargo. The scholarships are being offered through a partnership between North Dakota Local Technical Assistance Program (NDLTAP) and the Northland Chapter of ATSSA.



This unique offering is intended to raise awareness, increase overall knowledge and provide networking opportunities in the transportation safety industry. To be considered for this opportunity, you must be either a student enrolled in a transportation-related degree program or a local government employee/official attending the conference for the first time. Completed applications must be submitted to the NDLTAP as soon as possible. Applications will be reviewed as they are received and grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. The conference features multiple traffic safety training and information sessions and attracts more than 400 attendees from the transportation industry, including DOT employees, local government employees, contractors, consultant engineering firms, suppliers, service companies, and many more. A vendor fair with nearly 50 booths provides information and products for participants to gain more knowledge about transportation safety products.

# How-To Conference Grant Program (Local Gov)

The Northland Chapter of American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA) and NDLTAP are offering a limited number of grants to the Northland Chapter of ATSSA How To Conference in Fargo, ND (typically in March of each year). This unique offering is intended to raise awareness, increase overall knowledge, and provide networking opportunities in the transportation safety industry.

## Eligibility

Grants are available to local government employees/officials that are attending the conference for the first time and be either decision makers or workers in inspection, or maintenance of pavement markings, traffic signs, and temporary work zone traffic controls. Applicants must be employed with a county, city, township, or similar who work with roadway signing, markings, work zones, etc. on the roadway in order to be eligible.

## Terms

Grant recipients may only use the grant to pay for registration to the Northland Chapter of ATSSA How-To Annual Conference. Recipients of this grant are expected to attend the full conference. Recipients may be asked for testimonials at the conclusion of the conference in order to promote highway safety for our local government officials.

Applicants are evaluated by a UGPTI-NDLTAP selection committee. Selection criteria include:

- Applicant's position within their county, city, township, etc.
- Applicant's potential to contribute to roadway & work zone safety
- Applicant's need for assistance
- Past participation at the Northland Chapter of ATSSA How To Conference
