Classroom topics will cover how to: (9 a.m. – 12 p.m.)

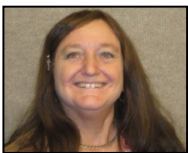
- Complete a pre-trip inspection and perform proper documentation

- Perform preventive maintenance on various equipment
- Recognize hazardous situations during the operation of heavy equipment
- Operate the equipment at the job site

Field Training (1 p.m. – 4 p.m.)

- This portion of the training will include demonstration on how to document a pre-trip inspection and identify defects on equipment. There will also be an exercise on how to identify blind spots, pinch points, pivot points and stability issues on equipment.
- Attendees will have an opportunity for hands-on operation of the above equipment on the maintenance lot to grasp the importance of blind spots, pinch points, pivot points and stability issues on equipment.
