- Operations Safety
- Safety During Shutdown
- Safety During Maintenance

Hands-on field portion will take the operators out to the mowers they operate. Participants will do a walk around inspection of the equipment. The classroom material will be reinforced and a driver's course will be set up that will allow each operator to demonstrate safety and proficiency with the equipment.
