This welding training will be a blend of classroom and hands-on practice in the shop. No prior welding experience is required. This class is designed to be a great refresher for experienced welders and a solid foundational class for anyone without any formal welding background.

Welding and repair work can be dangerous. Anthony will hand off a wide array of safety focus areas to help you and your crew avoid injuries and get home safe each night. Information about metals identification, mechanical properties, and heat treatments will provide participants with a unique and valuable learning opportunity. Anthony will cover:

- Welding basics, safety, stresses, distortion control
- Practical Metallurgy 1 Carbon Steel
 - Mechanical properties testing, heat treatments, metals identification
- Arc Welding SMAW (stick)
 - Shop & field welding, gouging and repair techniques
- Oxy-fuel Cutting & Safety

Participants should wear clothing suited for welding. Participants are encouraged to bring clothing, welding supplies and welding equipment that they would like to have Anthony inspect. His review will focus on product quality from a safety perspective.
