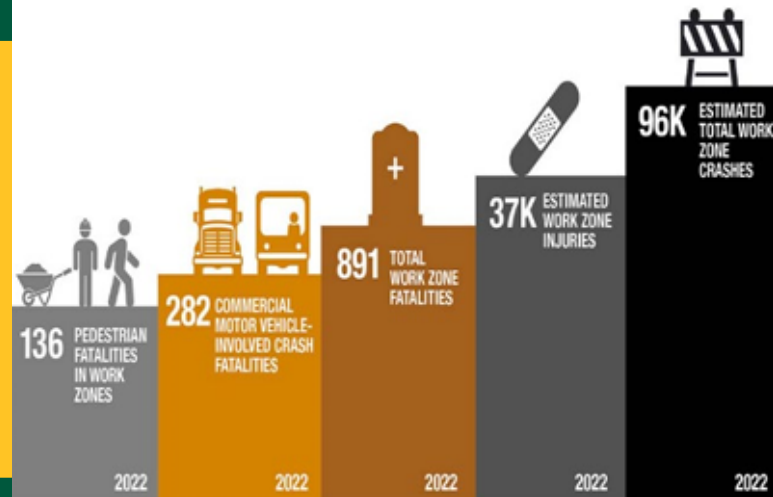


WORK ZONE SAFETY for LOCAL AGENCIES



WHY

This program will assist those working on the roadway in understanding the key elements used to control the traveling public as well as the employee's role in the development of a safe and effective work zone.

WHAT

The Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Part Six provides the basic requirements for Work Zone Traffic Control. As a part of this Traffic Control the MUTCD suggests the development of a traffic control plan that provides for both the safety of the traveling public as well as the employee.

WHO

Motor-grader operators, road supervisors, signing personnel, maintenance personnel, contractor, consulting engineers, project managers and safety officers.
